at 3 Pm got three cutting middle part gentle
Breeze from the South and Eastward latter
part the same employed in boiling
out the whale so ends their 24 hours
Lat obs 13. 37. 1 long in 87. 06 W

Saturday
February
the 9
1839

these 24 hours Commences with gentle breeze
from the North and Eastward three sails in
sits middle part strong winds from the
North and Eastward latter part the same
at 6 am past a white side brig all hands
employed in boiling the whale
so ends their 24 hours
Lat obs 13. 16 S long in 86. 53 W

Sunday
February
the 11
1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the North and Eastward one
sails in sits middle part strong winds
and Cloudy latter part the same at 12
o'clock got three boiling two sails in
sits so ends their 24 hours
Lat obs 12. 45 S long in 87. 01 W

Monday
February
the 11
1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the North and Eastward
employed in stowing down the ribs
middle part strong winds from the North and
Eastward latter part the same employed in
stowing down so ends their 24 hours
Lat obs 12. 20 S long in 87. 05 W

Tuesday
February
the 12
1839

these 24 hours Commences with lite wind from
South and Eastward at 6 pm got three stowing down
middle part lite winds and Cloudy weather
latter part the same seven sails in sits
saw the land so ends their 24 hours
Lat obs 12. 15 S long in 87. 15 W
