the 19
1839
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from
Eastward the land in site saw some boats off
a fishing middle part lite winds from the
Eastward latter part the same off to the
West of porumbuco So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 2. 12 S Long in 34. 30

Wednesday
February
the 20
1839
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from
the Eastward and pleasant weather two sails in
site middle part lite winds and pleasant weather
latter part the same two sails in site of us
and the land in site off at point gagan
So ends these 24 hours commences
Lat obs 4. 30 S Long in by Obs 34. 17. 15

Thursday
February
the 21
1839
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from
Eastward two sails in site and the land
middle part lite winds from the Eastward
and some squalls of rain latter part the same
two sails in site of us saw the land to west
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 6. 34 S Long in by Obs 34. 30

Friday
February
the 22
1839
these 24 hours commences with lite winds and
some squalls of rain two sails in site of us
and the land middle part lite winds and
some squally weather latter part the same
nothing in site of us to day
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 5. 18 S Long in 34. 10
