so ends these 24 hours
Lat ab 12.. 52 S long 56.. 59 W

Tuesday
march
the 12
1839

these 24 hours Commences with gentle
breezes from the Eastward and pleasant
weather nothing in the middle part like
winds from the Eastward latter part the
same at 6 a.m. saw two sails one to
the west and the other to the South at 10
a.m. saw the Island of Padoes bearing west
Lat ab 13.. 12 S long 58.. 10 W

Wednesday
march
the 13
1839

these 24 hours Commences with light winds from
the Eastward and pleasant weather the land in
the middle part light winds from the East
latter part the same one sail in the
the Island of Martinea in sight at us
so ends these 24 hours
Lat ab 14.. 12 long 60.. 11 W

Thursday
march
the 14
1839

these 24 hours Commences with light winds
from the Eastward and pleasant weather
middle part the same latter part
light winds from all round the compass
at 12 o'clock point bearing by
Compass East 15 miles
so ends these 24 hours
