the 15
1839

this 24 Commences with strong winds from the
N^W and raged wether saw a number of small
vessels middle part strong wind from the N^W
to N^W latter part the same and raged off to
the west of dominica so ends there 24 hour
Lat 15° 12' Long 61° 40'

Saturday
march
the 16
1839

this 24 hour Commences with strong winds from
N to E^{SE} and raged wether and thick
middle part the same and latter part a
gale from the North and Eastward in between
Dominica and godaloo so ends there 24 hour

Sunday
march
the 17
1839

this 24 hours Commences with a strong gale
from the E^{SE} and raged wether off godaloo
middle part strong winds from the North and
Eastward latter part more moderate sent the boat
on shore to get some wood so ends there 24 hours
laying off to the south of godaloo

Monday
march
the 18
1839

this 24 hours Commences with gentle breeze from
the North and Eastward at 3 pm the boat came
on board with a load of wood spoke the sooner
matissa of Portsmouth Capt Rowson sick
middle part gentle breeze from the East
latter part the same & astationous & joint
bar & so ends there 24 hour
