on board latter part fine weather at 12 O'clock took
on board some sweet potatoes and yams

march
the 20
1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
the Eastward and pleasant on shore bay few
middle part fine weather latter part the same
So Ends these 24 hours

Thursday
march
the 21
1839

these 24 hours Commences with gentle winds
from the North and Eastward and pleasant weather
at 2 Pm got under way in Hastakus and went
to sea middle part fine weather latter part the
same at 12 O'clock the west end of Santa Cruz
bearing by compass N N E Dis 15 miles
So Ends these 24 hours

Friday
march
the 22
1839

these 24 hours Commences with gentle breezes
from the Eastward and pleasant weather clearing
W S middle part strong winds and squally
weather latter part the same running down the
the south side of Portoreco So Ends these 24
Lat obs 17° 56' N Long at 4, 66° 31' W

Saturday
march
the 23
1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong winds
from the Eastward some squall hanging over
land saw three sails middle part fine wind
from the Eastward latter part the same
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 17° 52' N Long in 66° 33' W
