April

to 14

1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the westward at 4 Pm make the barkes ^{with} of falmouth Capt sickerson middle part lite winds from Eastward latter part lite winds from South employades in stowing down the sib so ends these 24 hours

Saturday

April

to 15

1839

these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from the westward and pleasant middle part lite winds from the south latter part strong winds from South and Eastward and Cloudy wether so ends these 24 hours

Sunday

April

to 16

1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong wind from the South and Eastward and Cloudy wether one bark in the middle part Gentle breezes from the Eastward and pleasant wether latter part the same Crossing off to the south of Portoreco so ends these 24 hours

Monday

April

to 17

1839

these 24 hours Commences with strong breezes from the Eastward middle part lite winds from the South and Eastward latter part fine wether employades in repairing the boat off to the south of Portoreco so ends these 24 hours
