the Eastward and squally at 4 Pm saw 4 sperm whale
heard the boats but did not get fast middle part strong
winds and some squalls of rain latter part the same
Saw a number of sails so Ends these 24 hours

Thursday
April
the 25
1839
these 24 hours commences with strong winds from the
Eastward and squally and rainy at 12 O'clock saw 4 sperm
whales heard and got two of them at 6 took them
along side and took in sail middle part strong
winds and squally latter part good weather employed
in cutting the whales at 12 O'clock got three
so Ends these 24 hours

Friday
April
the 26
1839
these 24 hours commences with gentle breezes from
the south employed in boiling middle part fine
weather latter part the same employed in boiling
at so Ends these 24 hours

Saturday
April
the 27
1839
these 24 hours commences with gentle breezes from
the south and Eastward at 2 Pm got the big victory of
presidence at 4 Pm saw whales heard the boats
and got fast and got one harbor boat got down
took him along side and later middle part good
weather latter part the same employed in boiling
so Ends these 24 hours

Sunday
April
the 28
1839
these 24 hours commences with gentle breeze
from the south at 6 Pm later the wind from the
south and strong middle part strong winds and some
squalls of rain at 8 Pm got new byling later part employed
stowing down so Ends these 24 hours
