May the 11
1839 These 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the
Eastward and squally middle part rainy later part some
like squall of rain off to the south of the white cliffs & down
So Ends these 24 hours

Sunday
May the 12
1839 These 24 hours Commences with gentle breezes from the
Eastward and some lingering squalls middle part like winds
and some squalls of rain later part fine weather with
So Ends these 24 hours

Monday
May the 13
1839 These 24 hours Commences with like winds and pleasant
middle part like winds from the North and Eastward
later part like winds from the Eastward and pleasant
off to the south of the white cliffs So Ends these 24

Tuesday
May the 14
1839 These 24 hours Commences with like winds from the
Eastward at 30 P.M. saw 4 firm whales heard the boats
and got three took them along side at 8 P.M. got
two of them later middle part like winds off the
land later part like winds in play in cutting in
the whale at 10 A.M. got three in cutting in
So Ends these 24 hours
