1839 part the same latter part fine weather for whaling
but no whales in site so Ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the south and East
May the 22 and pleasant weather off to the south of the white Chiffs middle part
1839 Lite winds and rainy latter part Lite winds and pleasant weather
but ops 17. 33.5 so Ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the South and
May the 23 Eastward and pleasant weather middle part Lite winds and pleasant
1839 latter part the same saw three sails bearing off to the
South of the attovals so Ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the
May the 24 South East and pleasant middle part Lite winds from
1839 the Eastward latter part strong winds from Eastward
and raged off to the south of the attovals so ends

Saturday these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
May the 25 the Eastward at 2 Pm saw sperm whales board the
1839 boats got fast and saw the iron out of line
middle part Lite winds and pleasant weather latter
part the same so Ends these 24 of the week

Sunday these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from the
May the 26 Eastward and pleasant middle part Lite winds from the
1839 Eastward latter part the same at 8 am saw
sperm whales board the boats and cast them
at 12 o'clock got fast to two and got them
so Ends these 24 hours
