miles from the reef at 8 Pm saw the Lite boat on
the Florida reef middle part Lite wind from
the East latter part Lite winds from the South
Saw a number of Sars a number of Cows
lat obs 25.. 35.. long 79.. 47..

Tuesday
June the 17
1839

these 24 hours commences with Lite winds
from the South middle part Lite winds from
the Eastward and pleasant weather latter part
the same one sail in site of us
So ends these 24 hours
lat obs 28.. 06 long is 79.. 20.. 50

Wednesday
June the 18
1839

these 24 hours commences with Lite winds from
the South and pleasant weather setting in site
middle part strong winds and pleasant
latter part the same one sail in site of us
lat 28.. 58 long is 78.. 45

Thursday
June the 19
1839

these 24 hours commences with strong winds from
the South at 2 Pm saw several whales heard
the boats and got one at 6 took him along
in middle part some squalls of rain latter
part good weather all hands employed in
cutting in the whale so ends these 24
lat obs 29.. 07 long is 78.. 14
