to the 29 North and Eastward and rough and squally and
1839 rain middle part strong winds from the North and
at 17.42 Eastward latter part the same saw one sail to the
by 36.51 leeward of us so ends these 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with strong winds from
to the 30 North and Eastward and same squally weather
1839 middle part gentle breezes from the Eastward
latter part the same saw a brig threatening
