1840 us middle part strong winds from the Eastward
lat 18.15 and raged latter part the same some squally
by 36.37 three sails in site So Ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
North the Eastward and raged wether middle part strong
1840 winds from the E S E and very raged wether
lat 17.08 latter part strong winds and raged nothing
by 36.16 in site So Ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from
North the E S E and raged wether nothing in site of us
1840 middle part gentle breezes from the Eastward and
pleasant latter part gentle winds and some little
