

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with light winds from
the Eastward and some squalls of rain off to the
1840 South of Comineco middle part light winds from
all round the compass later part light winds from the
Westward and pleasant weather off St. Raphael Bay
Comineco. So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with light winds from the
Westward at 3 PM saw blackfish board the boat but did
1840 not get fast middle part strong winds from the S.W.
later part strong winds off to the South of
Gaullog. Ends with Calms so ends the 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with Calms board soon
the boat and went on shore and got some foles
1840 middle part light winds from the S.W. and pleasant
weather later part the same off to the South of
St. Cite. So ends the 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with light winds from
the South and Eastward and pleasant weather at 6 PM
1840 we come to anchor to St. Estevan's wharf in
middle part light winds and pleasant weather later part
calms so ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with light Calms taking off
the 26 again at St. Estevan's middle part light winds
1840 from the Eastward and pleasant weather later
part light winds from the Eastward and
pleasant weather so ends the 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with gentle winds
from the Eastward and pleasant weather middle
1840 part fine weather later part the same
off to the South of St. Cite.
So ends the 24 hours
