winds from the Eastward and ragged weather and
a very squally latter part the same three
sails in sight of us off to the South of Cape
Roxo So ends these 24 hours

the Eastward and very ragged weather off to the
South of the Little Lillo middle part strong winds
and some thunder latter part strong winds
and ragged weather half way between Portorico and
the Isle of Laredo
