1840 these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from
the westward and pleasant weather one sail
in site of us middle part lite winds from
the westward latter part Lite winds from the
South and westward nothing in site to day
So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday
the 31
1840 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds
from the South and westward nothing in site
middle part Lite winds from the westward and
pleasant weather latter part Lite winds from
the South saw five sails to day pleasant weather
So ends these 24 hours

Thursday
the 1
1840 these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds from
the North saw a number of vessels to day
middle part lity breezes from the North
and eastward latter part strong winds from
the S & E and rugged weather saw one brig
to the East bound to the South
So ends these 24 hours

Friday
the 2
1840 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds
from the S & E and rugged weather nothing in
site middle part Lite winds from the East
latter part gentle breezes from the South
and eastward at 9 am saw blackfish
leards the boats but did not get fast
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday
the 3
1840 these 24 hours Commences with gentle breezes
from the North and Eastward and pleasant
weather nothing in site middle part very lite
winds from the Eastward latter part
calms had the fore topsail down to main
saw grampases nothing else in site
So ends these 24 hours
