of sail spoke the bark Richard Henry

Tuesday
July the 21
1840 these 24 hours commences with strong winds
from the westward and cloudy weather spoke the
bark Champion of westport Capt. Seab
middle part Lite winds from the North and westward
latter part the same at 9 am saw blackfish
board and got one took him along side and
cut him in So ends the 24 hour

Wednesday
July the 22
1840 these 24 hours commences with Lite winds from
the North and westward at 9 Pm saw sperm
whales board the boat and got one at 9 Pm
took him along side middle part Lite winds and
pleasant latter part the same all hands employed
in cutting So ends the 24 hour

Thursday
July the 23
1840 these 24 hours commences with Lite winds from
the North and eastward all hands employed in
cutting at 8 Pm got three mid part Lite and
pleasant weather latter part the same all hands in
employade in boiling sitting in sit to day
So ends the 24 hour

Friday
July the 24
1840 these 24 hours commences with Lite winds from
the Eastward and pleasant all hands employed in
boiling middle part Lite winds and pleasant weather
employade in boiling latter part the same
sitting sit of us to day
So ends the 24 hour
