these 24 hours Commences with strong winds from the
Southward and squally wetter two sails in site of us
middle part strong winds from the Eastward and
raining wetter latter part the same squally and
raining and thunder and lightning two sails in site
So Ends these 24 hours

Saturday
Sept the 5
1840
these 24 hours Commences with gentle breezes from
the South and squally and raining wetter two sails in site
middle part strong winds and squally some rain later
fine wetter two sails in site of us to day saw porpoises
So Ends these 24 hours

Sunday
Sept the 6
1840
these 24 hours Commences with light winds from the South
and pleasant wetter two sails in site to day as usual
middle part light winds from the South and raining
wetter latter part gentle breezes from the
South and Eastward two sails in site of us
So Ends these 24 hours

Monday
Sept the 7
1840
these 24 hours Commences light winds from the South
and Eastward and some light squalls of rain two sails
in site middle part light winds and some raining
latter part the same two sails in site of us
So Ends these 24 hours

Tuesday
Sept the 8
1840
these 24 hours Commences with light winds from
the South and Eastward middle part light winds
from the South and pleasant wetter latter part the
same two sails in site saw porpoises
So Ends these 24 hours

Wednesday
Sept the 9
1840
these 24 hours Commences with light winds from the
South and pleasant wetter two sails in site saw porpoises
middle part light winds from the South and Eastward
latter part the same two sails in site of us
saw porpoises and grampuses
So Ends these 24 hours
