Oct the 15
1840
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from
to westward saw one sail to the south and east
middle part lite winds from the south and west
latter part the same saw a number of vessels
bound to the Eastward
So ends these 24 hours

Friday
Oct the 16
1840
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from the
south and eastward and pleasant weather saw a
sail to the south bound to the Eastward middle part
strong winds from the southwest latter part strong
winds from the south west and raged weather nothing
in site
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday
Oct the 17
1840
these 24 hours commences with strong winds from
the southwest and raged weather nothing in site
middle part some very heavy squalls of winds and
rain from the south and westward latter part
strong winds from the south and very raged
So ends these 24 hours

Sunday
Oct the 18
1840
these 24 hours commences strong winds from the
north and westward and raged and squally
middle part the same squally weather
latter part strong winds from the north
and westward and very raged weather
So ends these 24 hours

Monday
Oct the 19
1840
these 24 hours commences with strong winds
from the north and westward and raged and
squally saw two sails to the east bound to
the Eastward middle part strong winds from
the north and raged weather latter part the
same. nothing in site of 1 unto day
So ends these 24
