Wednesday  
Oct the 21  
1840

these 24 hours commences with gentle breeze  
from the South and Eastward and pleasant  
middle part like winds from the South and East  
latter part strong wind from the South and  
pleasant weather saw a number of sails  
So ends these 24 hours

Oct 26.. 00  
Nov 66.. 01

Thursday  
Oct the 22  
1840

these 24 hours commences with strong wind from  
the South and Westward at 11 am spoke to  
brig Elizabeth of Westport Capt Cook  
at 11 am past a brig steering to the Eastward  
middle part a strong gale from the South West  
and very squally latter the wind shifted to  
the South and mad a bad sea  
So ends these 24

Oct 23.. 00  
Nov 69.. 00

Friday  
Oct the 23  
1840

these 24 hours commences with a strong gale  
from the S.W. and a bad sea on sea  
a ship bound to the Eastward employed in  
clearing a way for the water to get to the  
Purvey's middle part like wind from the South  
latter part like winds from the South and  
Eastward and pleasant weather nothing in site  
So ends these 24 hours

Oct 27.. 03  
Nov 68.. 53

Saturday  
Oct the 24  
1840

these 24 hours commences with like winds from the  
Eastward and pleasant weather nothing in site middle part  
very like winds from all round the Company's  
latter part the same saw grasses  
saw one ship bound to the Eastward  
So ends these 24 hours
