seen a sail bound to the western

Thurs June 2nd

more This day began with good Breeze from S.E.
at 4 P.M. raised a large whale drop
to late with out success finish boiling

Fri June 3rd

L.B. This day began with strong Southerly wind
large raised large whale drop Boats at 11.30 A.M.
boat struck got the whale long side
cut the Head off and rolled part the
body in parted 2 chains Lat 31-04
lost Head and Half the Body Lon 55-34

This day began with moderate Southerly
wind start the works

This day began with strong S.W. wind
later part calm heavy rain part at
the fire no O.
