This day began with light S.W. wind
all sail out Lat 84-00
Lon 50-42

Fri June 24th

This day began with light S.W. wind
all sail out Lat 83-14
Lon 49-28

Sat June 25th

This day began with strong S.W. wind
all sail out Bertha and manta in sight
Lat 88-18
Lon 49-23

Sun June 26th

This day began with strong S.W. wind
later part the same Bertha and manta
and Pedro varila in sight Lat 83-26
Lon 48-18

Mon June 27th

This day began with S.W. gale under short
sail all day later part rain Lat 34-00
Lon 47-57

Tues June 28th

This day began with S.W. gale under
short sail all day Pedro in sight
no Obs

Wed June 29th

This day began with light N.W. wind
heavy sea running spoke the carleton Bell
and Pedro varilla Lat 34-00
Lon 47-52

Thurs June 30th

This day began with strong S.W. wind
3 schooners in sight Lat 34-20
Lon 47-25

Fri July 1st

This day began with strong S.W. wind
later part the same seen 5 whales
no Obs

Sat July 2nd

This day began with strong S.W. wind
under short sail all day 20 schooners
in sight later part rain Lat 33-40
Lon 48-07
