Thurs Sept 29<sup>th</sup>

Thursday began with strong N.N.E. wind steering South Lat 30-15 Lon 25-25

Fri Sept 30<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong N.E. wind steering South Lat 29-55 Lon 24 44

Sat October 1<sup>st</sup> 1910

This day ~~day~~ began with strong trades steering South put in new leach rope in foresail Lat 23-56 Lon 23-58

Sun October 2<sup>nd</sup>

This day began with strong N.E. wind steering S by W Lat 23-20 Lon 23-43

Mon Oct 3<sup>rd</sup>

This day began with strong N.E. wind steering S by W. Lat 20-33 Lon 24-00

Tues Oct 4<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong N.E. wind steering South Lat 17-59 Lon 23 37

Wed Oct 5<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong N.E. wind steering S by W at night short in sail under St Nicolas

Thurs Oct 6<sup>th</sup>

This day began with fine weather drop boat went shore at St Nicolas angge some men

Fri Oct 7<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong N.E. wind lay to under short sail all day under St Nicolas
