all sail out great Fish Bay in sight  
seen the Schooner America

Sat Dec 24<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light S.W. wind  
all sail out later part the same  
Lat 16-00  
Lon 10-30

Sun Dec 25<sup>th</sup>

L.B. ✓ This day began with light S.E. wind later  
part strong at 2 P.M. raised Whales drop boats  
got one cut him in  
Lat 16-23 Lon 10-50

Mon Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong S.W. start the fire  
here on whaler  
Lat 16-30  
Lon 12-50

Tues Dec 27<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light S.E. wind clear  
all sail out Port Alexander in sight  
finish boiling and stand down

Wed Dec 28<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light S.E. wind all sail  
out later part the same  
Lat 18-30  
Lon 10-00

Thurs Dec 29<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light S.W. wind  
all sail out later part the same one whaler  
in sight  
Lat 18-20  
Lon 10-30

Fri Dec 30<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong S.W. wind  
all sail out seen one whaler Port Alexander  
in sight

Sat Dec 31<sup>th</sup>

✓ This day began with calm later part  
S.B. one strong breeze raised whales drop boats  
L.P. one got two Schooner America got whale  
cut the whale in  
S.B. Shore
