This day began with calm cut the whale
in and start the works land in sight.

Thurs Jan 5th

This day began with light S.W. wind
finish boiling

Fri Jan 6th

This day began with strong southerly
wind finish storing down the oil
no C.B.

Sat Jan 7th

This day began with light southerly wind
all sail out later part the same
land in sight

Jan 8th

This day began with strong S.W. wind under
short sail Lat 15-36
Lon 11-10

Mon Jan 9th

This day began with strong S.E. wind
later part light spoke the wanderer
and Morning Star land in sight

Tues Jan 10th

This day began with strong southerly wind
under short sail all day one whaler
in sight Lat 16-07
Lon 10-20

Wed Jan 11th

This day began with strong southerly wind
under short sail one whaler in sight
Lat 16-00
Lon 10-04

Thurs Jan 12th

This day began with light S.E. wind
later part calm spoke the Pedro Varela
and Brig Wicks

Fri Jan 13th

This day began with light S.W. wind
later part the same one whaler in sight
Lat 16-50
Lon 10-45

Sat Jan 14th

This day began with light S.E. wind all sail
out later part the same great fish Bay in sight
