Monday May 7th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light westerly winds made all sail at daylight Latter Part fine weather and light winds covered down the boats after tea, and exercised the crew took in sail at dusk. To end this day.

Tuesday May 8th 1866.

This day commenced with fine pleasant weather and light westerly winds made all sail at daylight crew employed in necessary work. Chiddle Part fine pleasant weather and light winds from the Westward steering N. by E. and the sail crew employed in necessary work. Latter Part quite fine weather took in sail at dusk and hoisted Ship's Land. This twenty four hours.

Wednesday May 9th 1866.

This day commenced fine weather and light winds from the N. by E. at daylight made all sail Ship by the wind. Hoisted Ship's Land. Chiddle Part fine pleasant weather and fresh breeze from N. W. to N. E. Ship by the wind, in different tack crew employed in necessary work. Latter Part fine weather and light winds from the N. by E. to E. N. E. took in sail and hoisted Ship's Land at dusk. To end this day.

Thursday May 10th 1866.

All this day fine weather and light baffling winds steering N. E. Chiddle Part fine weather and light winds from the N. by E. to E. N. E. saw a large man Boat Boat Lancer. Put out and went and had a look at it. Latter Part fine weather took in sail at dusk and hoisted Ship's Land. To end this day.

Friday May 11th 1866.

This day commenced with cloudy weather and fresh breeze from the N. by E. at daylight kept the Ship N. by E. and at the main topsail. At midday Part strong breeze from N. W. to N. E. hoisted Ship's Land and reefed main topsail. Latter Part wind and weather much the same. Saw quite a number of fishbacks. Took in sail at dusk and hoisted Ship's Land. To end this day.

Saturday May 12th 1866.

This day commenced with fine weather and light winds from the N. by E. at daylight kept the Ship N. by E. and at the main topsail. At midday Part fine weather and light winds from the N. by E. to E. N. E. Latter Part cloudy weather. at 4 P.M. lowered down all the Boats to practice. Pulling at dusk came on board and took in sail and hoisted Ship's Land. To end this day.

Sunday May 13th 1866.

This day commenced with cloudy weather and fresh breeze from the N. by E. at daylight set for topsail. saw a large man Boat to the N. E. Chiddle Part fine pleasant weather and light winds from the N. by E. to E. N. E. Latter Part strong breeze from E. to E. N. E. with much rain. Saw a large Barge Bound to the N. E. To end this day.

Monday May 14th 1866.

This day commenced with thick rainy weather and strong breeze from the N. by E. at daylight set for topsail. saw a large man Boat to the N. E. Chiddle Part fine pleasant weather and light winds from the N. by E. to E. N. E. Latter Part strong breeze from the N. by E. to E. N. E. with much rain. Saw a large Barge Bound to the N. E. To end this day.
