

Bay. Black Eagle. Edwin W. White Master
Saturday. Sept. 8th 1866.

This day dark Cloudy weather and fresh gales from the S.E. Capt and 2^d mate on Board trying out plenty of heavy Ice in the Harbor. Latter Part the wind hauled to the N.W. and did not end fine no whales seen to day.

Sunday. Sept. 9th 1866.

This day fine weather and fresh winds from the West. Capt on Board finished trying out whale turned up 140 lbs. oil also cleared the chain the Pack and on to the Land. no whales in the Bay. So ends This day.

Monday. Sept. 10th 1866.

This day fine weather and strong gales from the N.W. Capt and 2^d mate Stowing down Latter Part fine weather and calm moved Ship for winter quarters all hands came on Board So ends this day.

Tuesday. Sept. 11th 1866.

This day fine weather and pleasant breezes from the West. all 4 boats off cruising for whales. no whales seen to day 2^d mate shot a lot of ducks. Latter Part. wind S.W. and thick Snow storm. all boats hauled out for the night. So ends this day.

Wednesday. Sept. 12th 1866.

This day commenced with thick Snow storm and fresh breezes from West. all hands on the beach Latter Part wind N.E. Pack commencing in. So ends this day.

Lying In Repulse Bay, Greenland.
Thursday. Sept. 13th 1866.

All this day thick Snow storm and strong breezes from E.N.E. all the boats on the beach. no whales in sight plenty of heavy Ice in the Harbor. So ends this day.

Friday. Sept. 14th 1866.

All this day. fresh gales from the N.E. accompanied with Snow. Capt and 2^d mate returned to the Ship. Hall came to the Ship with 2 natives and 45 deer. So ends this day.

Saturday. Sept. 15th 1866.

This day fine weather and light winds. Capt and 2^d mate on Board trying Bone and string it down all the 4 Capt and getting ready to go to Gore Bay on a boat. expedition to explore for whales. So ends this day.

Sunday. Sept. 16th 1866.

This day fine weather and fresh breezes from N.W. the Captains all went off for Gore Bay. 2^d mate and Cooper of cruising for whales. but saw none shot 11 Geese 3 ducks and one Rabbit. ends with thick Snow storm.

Monday. Sept. 17th 1866.

This day fine weather and fresh gales from the West. 2^d mate stopped on board. baked out Bread and got off a cask of Water. So ends this day.

Tuesday. Sept. 18th 1866.

All this day fine weather and strong gales from the N.W. 2^d mate on Board. So ends this day.
