Monday, Oct 15th 1866.

All this day fine weather and light westerly winds finished getting ice and put 3 boats on shore. So ends this day.

Tuesday Oct 16th 1866.

All this day light cloudy weather and light baffling winds put 3 coaks on shore and 1 boat So ends this day.

Wednesday Oct 17th 1866.

This day fine weather and high winds from N.W. one family of natives came to the ship to day. 2^d and 3^d mate and 2 boatmen getting ready to go fishing and hunting with the natives So ends this day.

Thursday Oct 18th 1866.

This day fine weather & fresh breezes from the North. 2^d and 3^d mate started with the natives arrived at camp at 2 P.M. So ends this day.

Friday, Oct 19th 1866.

This day fine weather and fresh breezes from the North all started at 7 A.M. hunting and fishing. caught none 2^d mate and native shot a large white Polar Bear. arrived at camp at 10 P.M. with load of meat and dog skins. So ends this day.

Saturday Oct 20th 1866.

All this day fine weather and light winds from the West all hands fishing caught only one. So ends this day.

Sunday Oct 21st 1866.

All this day fine weather and light winds from the N.W. all hands went fishing with the native caught 4 fish. So ends this day.

Lying in winter quarters Repulse Bay.
Monday Oct 22nd 1866.

This day fine weather and fresh breezes from the North. gang returned from fishing with 4 fish. 1 deer & 1 Bear. killed the dogs to day and all the Captains and Officers had a game of Ball. So ends this day.

Tuesday, Oct. 23rd 1866.

All this day fine weather & fresh gales from the N.W. Ther. 2 above zero. ends fine

Wednesday Oct 24th 1866.

This day cloudy and light winds from the N.W. all hands sliding snow. So ends this day.

Thursday, Oct. 25th 1866.

All this day fine weather and strong breeze from the N.W. Ther at 0. Blanche returned to his camp for his family. So ends this day.

Friday Oct 26th 1866.

All this day fine weather and light westerly winds 3 native dog teams came to the ship to day. So ends this day.

Saturday Oct 27th 1866.

All this day cloudy weather and strong breezes from the S.W. accompanied with snow. So ends this day.

Sunday Oct 28th 1866.

Cloudy weather and southerly winds Mr. Wood and Mr. Marble went up to Ceapa Point with a dog team to look after the boats, got back at 10 P.M. So ends this day.

Monday Oct. 29th 1866.

All this day thick Snow Storm 2 natives went off with one of the boat steers. and got a load of meat. ends with a gale from S.E.
