Friday Dec 14th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and fresh breezes from the N.W. Ther 17° Below zero. all hands employed in building Snow Igloo. So ends this day.

Saturday Dec 15th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light westerly winds. Ther 21° Below zero. one of the natives returned from the Captains Preppits 3 Sannum Trout in 3 days. So ends these 24 hours.

Sunday Dec 16th 1866.

All this day cloudy weather and fresh breezes from the S.W. 2 natives went to the Captains with 10 dogs. this day ends with thick Snow Storm. So ends this day.

Monday Dec 17th 1866.

All this day cloudy weather and strong breezes from the S.W. accompanied with much snow. Ends with heavy gales from the S.W. So ends this 24 hours. Ther 16° Below

Tuesday Dec 18th 1866.

All this day strong breezes from the S.W. and much snow blowing. Ther 22° Below zero Mr. Hall took tea with the 2^d mates. This evening on board of this ship So ends this day.

Wednesday Dec 19th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light easterly winds. Ther 25° Below zero. all the Captains arrived at 10. Am having caught 11 Sannum Trout So ends this day.

Lying in winter quarters. In Repulse Bay.
Thursday Dec 20th 1866.

This day commenced with fresh breezes from the S.W. accompanied with snow. Latter part fine pleasant weather and calm. one dog team arrived from the Westside. Ther 22° Below zero. So ends this day.

Friday Dec 21st 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light northerly winds. 3 native dog teams went away for deer meat and hides to day. Ther 20° Below zero. So ends this day.

Saturday Dec 22nd 1866.

All this day fine weather and strong breezes from the N.W. Ther 33° Below zero. So ends this day.

Sunday Dec 23rd 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the N.W. Ther 30° Below zero. So ends this day.

Monday Dec 24th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light breezes from the N.E. our native Blucher returned to the ship this morning bringing 650 lbs of deer meat and a lot of skins. Officers employed in fitting up the Angel Gibbs house with Bunting for Christmas Eve. Ends with a dress Ball. So ends this day. (30 Below zero.)

Tuesday Dec 25th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.W. 3 dog teams went away to day. Ther 16° Below zero. So ends this day.

Wednesday Dec 26th 1866.

All this day Cloudy weather and light winds from the N.E. Ther 6° Below zero. So ends this day.
