Thursday Dec 27th 1866.

This day cloudy weather and light winds from the N. W. The mate went up to look at the boats on Craps Point also mate of the Cornelia 1 native and 1 egg team. Ther 22° Below zero. So ends this day.

Friday Dec 28th 1866.

This day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the N. W. Ther 12° Below zero. all the mates getting ready to go on a fishing excursion. So ends this day.

Saturday Dec 29th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light breezes from the N. W. 2 dog teams arrived with deer meat to day. Ther 12° Below zero. This day ends with strong gales from the N. W. So ends this day.

Sunday Dec 30th 1866.

All this day heavy gales from the N. W. accompanied with thick snow storm. Ther 12° Below zero. ends with heavy gales from N. W. Monday Dec 31st 1866.

All this day heavy gales from the N. W. accompanied with heavy snow storm. Ends pleasant with S. E. winds. Captains and Officers danced the old year out and new year in. So ends 1866.

Lying in Repulse Bay Harbor Winter Quarters
New years Day 1867.

This day commenced with strong breezes from the S. E. and snow all 4 mates started at 10 Am on a fishing excursion. Ends with fine weather and strong breezes from the S. E. Broke out Beef & Pork and got a load of Ice. Glass at zero. So ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 2nd 1867.

All this day cloudy weather & strong winds from the S. E. to N. E. Ther 10° Below zero. Broke out Flour & Barley. So ends this day.

Thursday Jan 3rd 1867.

All this day cloudy weather and fresh breezes from the N. E. to S. E. Ther 12° Below zero. So ends these 24 hours.

Friday Jan 4th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light N. W. winds got a load of Ice, several natives arrived from the mates camp reports 8 fish & fish very scarce. Got off sled load of Ice Ther 24° Below zero. So ends this day.

Saturday Jan 5th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather light winds from N. W. to S. W. Ther 24° Below zero. So ends this 24 hours.

Sunday Jan 6th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and calm. all the mates returned from their fishing excursion having caught 11 fish. Ther 30° below zero. So ends this day.

Monday Jan 7th 1867.

All this day cloudy weather & fresh breezes from the S. E. accompanied with snow. So ends these twenty four hours. Ther 14° Below zero.
