So ends this day.

Wednesday Jan. 9th 1866.

All this day Beautiful weather
and light winds from the N.E. Ther 28° Below zero
a gang came back from fishing having caught
one fish. crew got off a load of ice. So ends this day.

Thursday January 10th 1866.

This day commenced
with cloudy weather and fresh breezes from the
N.W. Middle Part and latter heavy gale from
the N.E. and thick Snow Storm Ther 26°
Below zero. So ends this day.

Friday Jan. 11th 1866.

All this day heavy gale
from the N.W. accompanied with thick
Snow Storm. Ther 18° Below zero So ends this
Twenty four hours.

Saturday Jan. 12th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and fresh breezes from the N.W. got
a load of ice. Ther 22° Below zero. So ends this day.

Sunday Jan. 13th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and fresh breezes from the N.W.
Ther 28° Below zero. Glacier got a Wolf. So ends.

Monday Jan 14th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and fresh breezes from the N.W. So ends this
day.

Tuesday Jan. 15th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and light winds from the N.W. Ther
35° Below zero. So ends this day.

Lying In Repulse Bay Greenland
Wednesday January 16th 1866.

All this day fine
pleasant weather and fresh breezes from the
N.W. Ther 30° Below zero. So ends this 24 hours.

Thursday Jan. 17th 1866.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and fresh breezes from the N.W. Ther 29°
Below zero So ends this day.

Friday Jan 18th 1866.

This day fine pleasant weather
and light airs from the N.W. Ther 32° Below zero.
one native dog team gone away to day. So ends
this day.

Saturday January 19th 1866.

Cloudy weather and
fresh breezes from the S.E. 2nd mate and
3 natives & 16 dogs started after deer meat. Broke
out meat & onions. ends with southerly winds
Ther 5° Below zero. So ends this day.

Sunday Jan. 20th 1866.

Commenced with fine
weather and fresh breezes from the N.W. natives
employed in Building a large Igloo for the
Sailors to shelter in. Southerly Part winds N.E.
Ther 10° Below zero So ends this day.

Monday Jan 21st 1866.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and light winds from the N.E. 2nd mate
and natives arrived with 8 deer. Ther 6° Above zero
So ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 22nd 1866.

All this day light airs from
the East. Ther 4° above zero. So ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 23rd 1866.

All this day pleasant
weather and slight southerly winds
Ther 10° Below zero. So ends this day.
