

Barge Black Eagle. Edwin P. White Master.
Thursday Jan 24th 1867.

This day commenced with fine pleasant weather and light Southerly winds. Captains White & Potter went to the Ice Edge 7 miles from the Ship. Latter Part heavy weather and light S.E. winds Ther 8° Below zero. So ends this day.
Friday January 25th 1867.

This day commenced with thick foggy weather and Snow. Light winds from the N.E. Latter Part ends with fine pleasant weather and light Southerly winds. Ther 2° above zero. So ends this day.

Saturday January 26th 1867.

All this day heavy gales from the N.E. Ther 18° Below zero. So ends this day.
Sunday Jan 27th 1867.

This day fine pleasant weather and light Southerly winds Ther 37° Below zero. Several native teams left the harbor to day. So ends this day.
Monday Jan 28th 1867.

All this day Strong gales from the N.E. and thick cloudy weather. Ther 25° Below zero. So ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 29th 1867.

This day cloudy weather and light winds from the S.W. to S.E. Ther 38° Below zero. So ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 30th 1867.

All this day cloudy weather and light winds from the S.W. Ther 35° Below zero. One native dog team went to the Ice Edge to day. Saw a Wolf and shot at him. So ends this day.
Thursday Jan 31st 1867.

This day commenced with Strong Breeze from S.W. with Snow. Glass at 20° Below zero. Middle and Latter Part fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.W. So ends this day.

Lying in Repulse Bay Greenland.
Friday Feb 1st 1867.

This day cloudy weather and light winds from the S.E. Ther 30° Below zero. One dog team arrived to day. So ends this day.

Saturday Feb 2nd 1867.

This day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the East. 3 dog teams came each bringing a Sledge load of deer meat. 70 miles our native bringing 400 lbs. Ther 28° Below zero. So ends this 24 hours.

Sunday Feb 3rd 1867.

All this day fresh gales from S.E. W. accompanied with Snow. Ther 19° Below zero. So ends this twenty four hours.
Monday Feb 4th 1867.

This day commenced with heavy gales from the N.E. accompanied with Snow. Latter Part fine pleasant weather and winds S.W. Ther 13° Below zero. So ends this twenty four hours.
Tuesday Feb 5th 1867.

This day fine pleasant weather and light winds from S.W. Thermometer 37° Below zero. Several dog teams left the harbor to day. So ends this day.
Wednesday Feb 6th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.W. Ther 39° Below zero. All the Pelle Bay natives left the harbor to day. So ends this day.
Thursday Feb 7th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.W. Ther 40° Below zero. All four of the Captains started on a fishing voyage. Mr. Hall with 2 natives started South to Bay dogs of the natives. So ends this day.

Coldest day this winter up to this date.
40° Below Zero
