came down from the Captain's for more fuel had
caught 2 Salmon. So ends this day.
Sunday Feb 10th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather
and light winds from the N.W. Ther 38° Below zero.
One dog team arrived to day from the Captain's
So ends this day.
Monday Feb 11th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant
weather and light winds from the N.W. Ther 38° Below
zero. So ends this day.
Tuesday Feb 12th 1867.

All this day cloudy weather &
light Easterly winds Ther 41° Below zero. all the Captain's
arrived from fishing having caught 6 fish weighing
about 75 lbs. several of the natives went fishing for
Seal to day but caught none. So ends this day
Wednesday Feb 13th 1867.

This day fine pleasant
weather and light winds from the S.E. Ther 28°
Below zero. three of the Chukmats went fishing with
several of the natives. So ends these 24 hours.
Thursday Feb 14th 1867.

All this day Cloudy weather
and fresh breezes from S.E. accompanied with snow.
The mates returned from fishing having caught
one fish. natives all went Sealing but caught none
So ends this day.

Friday Feb 15th 1867.

This day commenced with Strong
Breezes from S.E. accompanied with Snow Latter
Part heavy gales from N.W. Ther 12° Below zero.
So ends this day.
Saturday Feb 16th 1867.

All this day heavy gales from the
N.W. accompanied with thick Snow storm
Ther 18° Below zero. So ends these twenty four hours.
Sunday Feb 17th 1867.

All this day heavy gales from
the N.W. Ther 25° Below zero. So ends this day
Monday Feb 18th 1867.

All this day heavy gales from
N.W. accompanied with thick Snow Storm
Several families came back from sealing having
such stormy weather they could not seal. Ther 31°
Below zero. So ends this day.
Tuesday Feb 19th 1867.

This day commenced with
heavy gales from the N.W. Latter Part more
moderate. Ther 28° Below zero. So ends this day.
Wednesday Feb 20th 1867.

This day commenced with fresh
gales from the N.W. accompanied with Snow.
Middle Part quite fine weather and light air from
N.W. got off two loads of ice Latter Part Strong breezes
from the Northward. Thermometer 25° Below zero. So ends this day

Thursday Feb 21st 1867.

All this day fine weather & light
winds from the S.E. Ther 23° Below zero. got off a load of
Ice and Built an Igloo. So ends this day.
