

Barque Black Eagle Edwin W. M. M. Master.
Friday Feb. 22nd 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.E. all hands employed in putting up hunting for the Bell on Board of the Ansel Libby. This day ends fine Ther 26° Below zero.

So ends this day.
Saturday Feb. 23rd 1867.

All this day thick hazy weather and fresh breezes from the S.E. kept up the Dance until 4th this morning Ther 23° Below zero. So ends these twenty four hours.

Sunday Feb. 24th 1867.

This day commenced with heavy gales from the S.E. and thick Snow Storms. Middle Port much the same. Latter Port fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.E. one of the natives women died at noon today having been sick 3 months. Ther 5° Below.

So ends this day.
Monday Feb. 25th 1867.

Monday is fine all day breeze light winds from the S.W. Ther at 6 A.M. 18° Below 0 in the Shade at noon 2° Above 0 in the Sun. So ends Tuesday Feb. 26th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather & light winds from the West. Ther 26° Below zero. So ends this day.

Wednesday Feb. 27th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light winds from the S.W. Ther 32° Below zero. All the 2nd mates getting ready to go on fishing excursion. So ends this day.

Thursday Feb. 28th 1867.

This day commenced with fine pleasant weather and light Westerly winds. All the Second mates started on a fishing cruise. Middle and Latter Port. Strong Westerly winds Ther 33° Below zero. So ends this day.

Lying In Repulse Bay, Greenland.
Friday March 1st 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light westerly winds. Natives all off a Sealing Ther 35° Below zero. So ends this day.

Saturday March 2nd 1867.

This day commenced with Strong breezes from the South and cloudy weather. All the natives off after Walrus. Middle Port light S.E. winds got a load of Ice and Broch'd a new cask of Breach. Latter Port light Northwesterly winds Ther 22° Below zero. So ends this day.

Sunday March 3rd 1867.

Fresh Breezes from the S.E. and cloudy weather. Middle Port Strong breezes from the S.W. and thick weather. All the natives returned from the Ploc Edge with one Walrus. Latter Port Strong breezes from the S.W. & thick weather. Ther 23° Below zero. So ends this day.

Monday March 4th 1867.

Commenced with a heavy gale from the N.W. accompanied with Snow. Middle Port more moderate two natives arrived from the high Pond. 2nd mates had caught 7 fish. Latter Port light N.W. winds with Snow. Ther 32° Below zero. So ends this day.

Tuesday March 5th 1867.

All this day light Baffling winds and thick hazy weather. All the second mates returned from fishing having caught 7 fish. Ther 26° Below 0. So ends this day.

Wednesday March 6th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light Westerly winds. All the natives off Sealing to day but caught none. Ther 26° Below zero. So ends this day.
