

Barge Black Eagle Edwin W. White Master.

Saturday June 27th 1867.

All this day cloudy & rainy weather with fresh Easterly winds very little sea.

Sunday June 30th 1867.

All this day cloudy weather & strong Easterly winds. So ends this day.

Monday July 1st 1867.

All this day strong Easterly winds with snow. So ends this day.

Tuesday July 2nd 1867.

This day fine weather & light Easterly winds. Captain White returned to the ship with his boat & boat crew leaving the 2nd mate & Cooper to whale. 1 man came up from each of the 4 boats at Beach Point for more provisions reports very little water & no chance to get to Whale Point.

Wednesday July 3rd 1867.

This day light cloudy weather and strong breezes from the E. & S. E.

Thursday July 4th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light baffling winds. Saw a few white whales for the first time this season, quite a space of water. So ends this day.

Friday July 5th 1867.

All this day fine pleasant weather and light N. E. winds. Saw 1 walrus. So ends this day.

Saturday July 6th 1867.

This day calm with light winds from N. E. & fine weather. Middle Part fine & strong breezes from the N. E. at 2 P.M. the ice broke off the Kalls Island. 2nd mate & Cooper came to Kalls Island at 4 P.M. with their boats. dog team arrived from ship with more provisions. So ends this day.

Sunday July 7th 1867.

All this day dark cloudy weather. Strong breezes from N. E. Ice set well off nearly all the natives arrived left Kalls Island.

Syng In Repulse Bay Greenland.
Monday July 8th 1867.

This day cloudy weather & light winds from N. E. & S. E. 2nd mate started for Beach Point arrived there at 11 A.M. and found John & Budlong. Lost one of the ship's crews. So ends this day.

Tuesday July 9th 1867.

All this day fine weather & light N. W. winds. 2nd mate returned from Beach Point. no tidings of the lost man arrived at Kalls Island at 2 P.M. So ends this day.

Wednesday July 10th 1867.

All this day fine weather & calm. mates started from Beach Point for Whale Point. So ends this day.

Thursday July 11th 1867.

First & Middle Parts calm & fine weather. Latter Part fine weather & fresh breezes from S. E. 2nd mate started for Beach Point arrived at 10 P.M. 3 hours from Kalls Island.

Friday July 12th 1867.

This day foggy weather & light winds from the S. E. found the missing man 3 miles from Camp. shot 1. large Buck. So ends this day.

Saturday July 13th 1867.

This day fine weather & light baffling winds. heavy pack set in last night started from Beach Point at 1 A.M. arrived at Kalls Island at 6 P.M. Had to haul boats over some ice. So ends this day.

Sunday July 14th 1867.

All this day heavy gales from the Eastward accompanied with much rain & a little of the floe ice broke off from Kalls Island. So ends this day.

Monday July 15th 1867.

This day light cloudy weather and light breezes from the E. to E. N. E. one of the men shot a large deer. So ends this day.
