Friday June 23rd

All these 24 hours fresh breezes from WNW and pleasant weather steering SE by E one sail in sight seen variously employed in ship duty so ends this day
Lat 38° 14' Lon 64° 20'

Saturday June 24th

First part of these 24 hours fresh winds from the WNW and fine weather one sail in sight Middle and latter part pleasant breezes from the SW steering SE by E at 6 am set the fore top mast Studding sail No whale in sight so ends this day
Lat 38° 20' Lon 62° 39' Chron

Sunday June 25th

These 24 hours commences with winds from the SW and thunder and squalls of rain steering SE by E Middle and latter parts strong winds from the WNW took in the fore mast Studding sail so ends this day Lat 38° 55' N
Lon by Chronometer 57° 32' W

Monday June 26th

First part of these 24 hours strong wind from the WNW and cross sea steering SE by E Middle part squally with rain and lightning Latter part pleasant winds from the WNW saw one whale but did not find out what he was at 9 o'clock saw a bale of cotton but did not lower being too nuff so ends this day

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Friday June 27th

These 24 hours commences with light winds from the NW and clear weather Middle part calm latter part moderate winds from the SE heading E by N so ends this day nothing in sight No whale
Lat by Chron 40° 09' Lon by Chron 56° 26'

Wednesday June 28th

First part of these 24 hours light wind and rainy weather and thick Middle part heavy rain and fresh winds from WNW with a cross sea in latter part pleasant one sail in sight steering to the SE so ends this day No whale in sight Lat 41° 00' N
Lon in by Chron 53° 18' West

Thursday June 29th

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather and a cross sea heading to the E by N Winds from the NW one sail in sight in the evening Middle and latter parts pleasant weather with light winds so ends this day
Lat 41° 39' N Lon by Chron 51° 58' W

Friday June 30th

First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather at 11 AM lowered three boats for black fish but did not gett fast came on board at 4 PM lowered a gain for black fish and gott sight and hoisted them on Deck men employed in clearing away the blackfish chace and latter part rainy weather and winds from the NW so ends this day with rain and fog
