from the Northward steering S by W

sight steering to the NE on
a wind saw a school of black
fish so ends this day

of rain at 4 P.M. lowered the two
sails and went to making some wild
shots at 6 P.M. up the boats middle
part light air from the NW steering
South latter part raining steady

West a heavy head beat sea from
the Southward so ends this day

These 24 hours commences with fresh wind
from the SW and squally weather and
heavy rain middle and latter parts
strong winds from the Southward
with squalls of rain and a heavy
sea heading from SE by S to SE by E
topgallant sails furled so ends this
