

Indian Chronology Nov 9th

Thursday Nov 9th
All these 24 hours Pleasant weather winds
from the NW steering ESE
Saw a number of fin back whales
but no white whales to ends this
day Lat 35° 08' South
Lon by Chron 72° 13' East

Friday Nov 10th
All these 24 hours strong winds from
the Westward steering ESE at 8 PM
hauled up SE carried sail throughout
the night saw several fin back
whales to ends this day
No white whales Lat 35° 51'
Lon by Chron 74° 52' E

Saturday Nov 11th
First part of these 24 hours strong
winds from the Westward steering
SE thick hazy weather middle
part strong winds and Rainy
steering SE latter part moderate
winds and hazy weather to ends
fin back fin back whales no ends
but no white whales
Lat 37° 21' South
Lon by Chron 77° 34' East

Sunday Nov 12th
These 24 hours commences with light
winds from the NW and hazy
weather steering SE at 5 PM saw
the Island of St Paul bearing 100°
Dist 12 miles at 9 PM kept of
East moderate winds and Pleasant
weather latter part strong winds
from the Northward and Rainy
weather saw several fin back
whales but no white at 9 PM
set the fore topmast standing
sail for ends this day
Rainy thick weather
No Ob this Day

Indian Chronology Nov 13th

Nov 13 Saturday
First part of these 24 hours strong winds
from the Northward and Rainy weather
middle and latter part winds from
the Westward and Rainy steering East
saw several fin back whales to ends
this day no observation

Nov 14 Sunday
All these 24 hours winds from the
Westward steering East by compass
Rain and fog throughout the day
saw nothing this day but birds
to ends this day no whale
No Ob this Day Lat 35° 40'
Lon by Chron 87° 12' East

Wednesday Nov 15th
First and middle parts of this day
fog and Rain steering East by
compass winds from the Westward
latter part Pleasant weather saw
a number of fin back whales
but no white whales to ends
this day Lat 35° 02' South
Lon by Chron 90° 00' East

Thursday Nov 16th
45th First part of these 24 hours
light winds from the Westward
and Pleasant weather steering
ESE at 3 PM saw a white whale
lowered for him got fast and turned
him up at 5 PM took him a long
side commenced getting up the cutting
gear commenced cutting in let
him hang a long side till moving
middle part latter part strong winds
from the NW and Rainy weather
at 11 AM got through cutting
to ends with a heavy gale
