Thursday February 8<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day strong winds from the W.N.W steering N.E. middle part strong winds from the S.W and Rainy weather steering N.E. by N Latter part moderate winds and pleasant weather Bound to the N.W. with all possible sail Sett Carpenter employed in mending stover boats so ends this 24 hours  
Lat 0° 34' 30" South  
Lon by Chrono 153° 42' West

Friday Feb 9<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours pleasant weather winds from the S.W steering N.W. with all sail Sett to the best advantage employed in fitting a new Sett of Butting Tenants and repairing boats and other necessary work so ends this day  
Lat 0° 32' 50" South  
Lon by Chrono 152° 20' West

Saturday Feb 10<sup>th</sup>

First and middle parts of these 24 hours light winds from the S.E. and pleasant weather steering N.W. by E Latter part winds from S.E. took in the lower studding sail employed in laying up rope and so forth saw nothing this day so ends  
Lat 0° 30' 52" S  
Lon by Chrono 152° 10' West

Bound to the Northward and

Canada Feb 11<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day strong winds from the Eastward steering to the N.W. by E and a wind took the studding sails and flying Gib and left topsail middle and latter part strong winds and cloudy weather took topgallant sails saw nothing this day  
Ends Lat by Chrono 28° 50' South  
Lon by Chrono 151° 04' East

Sunday Feb 12<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commenced with strong winds from the Eastward Double crossed the fore topsail steering on a wind to the N.W. by E middle part the same latter part more moderate made all sail saw nothing this day  
Crews men employed in ship's duty Lat 0° 26' 18" South  
Lon by Lunar 150° 41' West  
Lon by Chrono 150° 48' West

Tuesday Feb 13<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours strong Easterly winds steering N.W. by E. At Meriden made the Island of Tobouai bearing N.E. by E Dist 25 miles men employed in repairing the fore topgallant sail Carpenter employed in repairing boats so ends this day  
Lat 0° 23' 44" South  
Lon by Chrono 150° 11' West  
Ship being 59 miles East of the Crown

Wednesday Feb 14<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day strong winds from the Eastward steering N.W. by N for the Island of Jacobou took in topgallant sail and ran in under the island at 4 PM sent a boat on shore at 5 PM at Boat came from the shore with letters at 7 PM the ship's boat came on board at 8 PM the shore boat left the ship a French ship was lost on the island 4<sup>th</sup> of Feb at 9 PM light of North middle part fresh winds from S.E. Latter part light winds from S.E. and rainy & No Obs this day
