the Ship and painting of Deck

Sunday Feb 25th
All these 24 hours light winds
with showers of rain one Watch
on Liberty so ended this Day
Ship then England Laying
in the harbor

Monday Feb 26th
All these 24 hours light winds
and calm with showers of
rain employed in wooding and
watering the Ship one Watch
on Liberty so ended this Day

Tuesday Feb 27th
All these 24 hours light winds
and Rainy Weather employed in
wooding and watering the Ship one
Watch on Liberty so ended this
Day

Wednesday Feb 28th
All these 24 hours Squalls of wind
and Rainy Weather employed in
getting wood and water one watch on
Liberty so ended this 24 hours
the New England in the same
harbor

Laying at Looe one of the
Thursday Feb 29th

All these 24 hours wind from the Northward
and Rainy Weather employed in wooding
the 9 AM 8 men went on shore bag and
baggage so ended this Day

Friday March 1st
All these 24 hours Northy winds and
Rainy Weather employed in wooding
Ship 4 men so ended this Day

Saturday March 2nd
All these 24 hours strong Northy
winds and Rainy Weather got through
wooding and watering the Ship
waiting for a wind to get out through
the Bay so ended

Sunday March 3rd
All these 24 hours commences with
strong winds from the North West
and Rainy Weather Laying in Dooley
Harbor wind bound waiting to clear
to get out two Ships one Brig and one
Schooner waiting for a wind to get
out

Monday March 4th
All these 24 hours Northy winds
with constant rain waiting to get
to sea so ended this Day

Tuesday March 5th
All these 24 hours Northy winds and
Rainy Weather waiting for a wind to
get to sea so ended this Day

Wednesday March 6th
All these 24 hours Northy winds and
Rainy Weather waiting for a fair wind
to get out to sea so ended this Day
the New England Laying in
the same harbor waiting to get out
