Sunday June 30th
First Part of this Day light wind
from the S.W. and Smokey weather
Employed in Stowing Down
oil in the fore hold at 4 P.M.
got through and Cleared up the
Decks middle and latter Parts
thick fog with light winds
from the Southward steering
S.W. & Saw several fin back
Whales in course of the Day but
No White So Ended this Day
the third mate Employed in
mending a Stoven Boat.
No Oil this Day

Monday July 1st
First Part of this Day light air
from the Southward and thick
fog middle and latter Parts fresh
winds from the S.W. and rainey
thick weather Employed in Cleaing
Boat and Repairing Stoven Boats
and so forth so Ended this Day
with thick fog and No Whales
No Oil this Day

Tuesday July 2nd
First and middle Parts of the
24 hours winds from the S.W.
and thick foggy weather Employed
in Cleaing Boat saw one White
Whale close to the Ship but
it was too thick fog to lower
at 3 A.M. made sail at
4 A.M. Rose two White Whales
and lowered for them got fore
and Drawed the Boats Came
on board at 8 A.M. at 10 A.M.
Rose a White Whale going
so Ended this Day Storing
after Whales Latt Oil 55.93
Lon By Chr 152.25

N. West Coast of America 1844
Wednesday July 3rd
These 24 hours Commenced with light
winds from S.W. and hazy weather
at meriden lowered all three Boats
got fast turned him up and the
Whale sunk lost one line by him
at 2 P.M. the Boats came on
board at 3 P.M. lowered again for
Whales got fast got one Boat close
to him the other Boat got loose by
a iron bracing the Whale went
of middle Part strong gales from
S.W. and thick rainey weather latter
the same one Ship in sight
so Ended this Day No Oil

Thursday July 4th
First and middle Parts of this 24
hours light winds from the S.W.
and thick foggy weather latter Part
Calm and clear weather saw a
great many fin back Whales
but No White Whales Employed
in repairing Stoven Boats so Ended
this Day Latt Oil 55.26



Friday July 5th
First Part of this Day Calm at
2 P.M. Rose a Dead Whales went
to him with one Boat but it was
good for nothing got one iron out
of it at 4 P.M. Rose a White Whale
lowered for him got fast at 4 P.M.
took him along side middle Part
Whale fore the S.W. and Rainey
at 4 A.M. hooked on to the whale
got one lip and had to give him
up blowing a gale of wind and
rain so Ended Whale along side
being too rough to cut
Wind S.E.
