Thursday Sept 5th
All these 24 hours fresh gales from the
S.W. and squally with rain steering
S by W by compass two ships in sight
men employed in ships duty so on
Lat 38° 45' North

Friday Sept 6th
All these 24 hours fresh gales from
the Eastward steering S by W nothing
in sight this day employed in
Drying and Bundling Bore sent
the Studding sail Bore on to the
yards and set fore topmast
studding sail and main topgal
ant studding sail so on this
day Leaking very bad

Lat 36° 46' N
Long by Chr 144° 12' W

Saturday Sept 7th
All these 24 hours fresh gales from
the Eastward and squally rainy
weather took in and made sail
as occasion Required steering
S by W nothing in sight this
day so on this 24 hours

Sunday Sept 8th
All these 24 hours variables and
squally weather with rain wind
from N.W. to S.W. steering
S by W took in and made
sails as occasion Required
through the day No Whales
or any thing else in sight
so on Lat 33° 05'
Long by Chr 146° 53'

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Monday Sept 9th
First and middle parts of this
day Baffling winds and squally
with thunder and lightning
and heavy rain winds from
S.E. to N.E. latter part wind
from N.W. and clear took in
and made sail as occasion
Required through the 24 hours
so on this day nothing in
sight Lat 31° 36' N
Long by Chr 147° 52' W

Tuesday Sept 10th
All these 24 hours fresh winds
from N.W. to S.W. and squally
with heavy rain steering S by W
took in sail and made sail
as occasion Required nothing in
sight this day so on
Lat 30° 06' North
Long by Chr 148° 57' West

Wednesday Sept 11th
Throughout these 24 hours Baffling
winds and squally with rain steady
from S.W. to N.W. winds from
Winds from N.E. to S.W. in
squally nothing in sight this day
so on Lat 28° 34' N

Thursday Sept 12th
All these 24 hours Baffling winds and
squally with rain steering on a
wind to the S. and West winds
from East to S.E. one ship in
sight steering S.W. nothing in
shape of Whales in sight this day
employed in Bundling Bore
so on this day
Lat 26° 58' North
