Friday Sept 13th
All these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. and passing clouds with squalls of fine rain steering S by W at meriden spoke the barge Mary Frazier of New Bedford 27 men out 700 sperm oil 1500 whale men employed in ship's duty Cooper employed in setting up pipes for fresh water over ship in light saw no whales this day so ended leaking freely Lat 25° 06' N Lon by Chr 152° 48' W

Saturday Sept 14th
All these 24 hours fresh winds from the S.E. with squalls of rain steering S by W at meriden spoke the barge Mary Frazier of New Bedford 27 men out 700 sperm oil 1500 whale men employed in ship's duty Cooper employed in setting up pipes for fresh water so ended this day Lat 23° 41' N Lon by Chr 153° 45' W

Sunday Sept 15th
All these 24 hours fresh winds from the Eastward steering S.W. and squally with rain the barge Mary Frazier of New Bedford in company so ended this day Lat 21° 34' N Lon by Chr 154° 13' W

Monday Sept 16th
First part of this day strong S.E. winds steering S.W. middle part squally with fine rain at 8 P.M. kept off W by S at 6 P.M. saw no whales one of the Sandwich Island bearing S.W. Dist 60 miles latter part fine clear weather steering for the Mary Frazier in company so ended this day employed in washing the ship Lat 21° 06' N Lon 156° 03' W

First part of this day strong winds from the S.E. steering S.W. the barge Mary Frazier of New Bedford in company so ended this day at anchor at noon so ended this day

Wednesday Sept 18th
First part of this day light squalls at 5 P.M. anchored in Mowee beach middle and latter part light air so ended employed in painting and so forth

Thursday Sept 19th
All these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather employed in painting and watering so ended

Friday Sept 20th
All these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather variously employed so ended this 24 hours

Saturday Sept 21th
All these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather employed in ship's duty so ended

Sunday Sept 22th
All these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather employed in ship's duty so ended these 24 hours

Monday Sept 23th
All these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather staying at anchor at Mowee so ended this day
