by S. So ends this day leaking
very bad Lat 17.59 N
Long by Chr 158.12 W

Thursday Sept 28th

All these 24 hours strong NE
trade winds steering by S
Nothing in sight this day
men employed in ship
duty so ends this day
Leaking 500 strokes per hour
Lat 15.23 N
Long by Chr 153.20

Round homeward Sept 29th

Sunday Sept 29th
All these 24 hours strong NE trades
and squally steering by compass
Nothing in sight this day leaking
from 2 to 500 strokes per hour
split flying jib took it in and furlled
took in the soft top so ends
Lat 12.44 N
Long by Chr 158.31 W

Monday Sept 30th
All these 24 hours strong NE trades and
squally with rain steering by S. Nothing
in sight this day split the main
sailant sail and flying jib on board
the topantail and another one
on board the flying jib so ends this
day repairing sails and other ships duty
Leaking very bad Lat 11.14 N

Tuesday Oct 1st
All these 24 hours strong NE trades and
squally steering by S. Nothing in
sight this day employed in repairing
sails and so forth Leaking 1000 strokes
per day so ends this 24 hours
Lat 09.22 N
Long by Chr 158.29 W

Wednesday Oct 2nd
All these 24 hours rainy weather with
strong squalls of rain from the
S. took in and made sail as
season required steering on
wind to the southward so ends
this day No. 11

Thursday Oct 3rd
First part of this day baffling wind
from the south and east and squally
with heavy rain middle part the
same latter part clear pleasant
weather wind from the southward
beating down to the south and
west so ends this day nothing in sight
