

Stamens Cape Horn Dec 7th

Saturday Dec 7th
Throughout these 24 hours fresh winds from the ESE heading to the South and East took in fore top galant sail men variously employed in blacksmithing turning, delaying pins, carpentering and so forth. Sailed a top for this day. No. 68. Sailed 11:32 P.M. Low by Chr 137. 11. 1/2.

Sunday Dec 8th
Throughout these 24 hours strong winds from the ESE and cloudy weather heading to the South and East on at 11:00 A.M. took in main top galant sail 11 A.M. double reefed the fore top sail at 2 P.M. double reefed over board out of the fore top sail and single reefed the main top sail. Sailed this day. Sailed 11:30 A.M. No. 36. Sailed. Low by Chr 135. 11. 1/2.

Monday Dec 9th
All these 24 hours strong winds from the ESE and cloudy weather heading to the ESE on at 11:00 A.M. took in main top galant sails over single reefed top sails took the station anchor of the bows and stowed it on deck turning South under way. Carpenter employed in repairing the Round-house. Fair one, White Whale. Sailed this day. No. 68. Sailed 11:30 A.M. No. 78. Sailed. Low 138. 11. 1/2.

Tuesday Dec 10th
These 24 hours commences with fresh winds from the ESE and squalls of fine rain and fog middle part moderate winds from the ESE and pleasant weather. Took the reef out of the top sails. Sailed the flying jib and jib top sail. Latter part light air and fine weather heading East. wind N.E. took the larboard anchor on deck. No. 68. Sailed. Low by Chr 131. 12.

Stamens Cape Horn Dec 11th

Wednesday Dec 11th
First part of this day fine pleasant weather winds from the Northward steering East. Latter part topmast standing sad and main top galant standing sail middle part fair air from the ESE. Latter part light air. Took the fore top galant standing sail down to the yard and set the sail men employed in repairing the fore top sail on the deck and middle part of the day so forth. Sailed this day. No. 44. Sailed. Low by Chr 135. 11. 1/2.

Thursday Dec 12th
Throughout these 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather steering East wind N.W. Men employed in mending the jib and repairing it and the fore topmast staysail and other necessary work and so forth. Sailed this day. Sailed 11:30 A.M. No. 77. Sailed. Low by Chr 128. 11. 1/2.

Friday Dec 13th
First part of this day moderate winds from the Northward steering East middle part fresh winds from the Northward and cloudy at 9 P.M. took in lower standing sail at 5 P.M. set a gain. Latter part fresh winds at 7 P.M. took in lower standing sail men employed in ship's party. No. 68. Sailed this 24 hours. Sailed 11:30 A.M. No. 50. Sailed. Low by Chr 125. 11. 1/2.
