

In Board the Sargue Black

Friday Jan^y 17th

First Part of this Day Strong Wind from the NW and hazy Weather heading to the North and West one Sail in sight middle Part Calm heading to the Eastward thick foggy Weather at 10 A.M. the fog cleared up and went the main Sail to repair men Employed in repairing the Standing sails and mainsail So Ended this Day Calm

Saturday Jan^y 18th

These 24 hours Commences with light Wind from the Northward and Cloudy Weather heading SE at 4 P.M. finished the mainsail and bent it and sent the gaff topsails aloft saw one fin Back Whale from Aboft. but No White Whales middle Part thick Rainy Weather Wind from the NW took in topgalantsails at 10 P.M. and Double Reefed the top Sails latter Part light Winds from the SW and Pleasant Weather Steering NW by N all the Standing sails set this Day one Ship in sight Steering to the Southward So Ends

Sunday Jan^y 19th

These 24 hours Commences with Calm Weather one Ship in sight middle Part Wind N by E and Rain Steering on N Wind to the Northward at 4 A.M. the Wind shifted to the Westward in it equal Close Reefed the topmasts furled the mainsail Shoved up the fore topsail and pushed it at 7 A.M. hove too under a Close Reefed main topsail head to the NW turned up the Starboard quarter Boat and hoisted up the others So Ended at heavy gale of Wind with heavy squalls of Rain

Mon of (Mystice Jan^y 20th

Monday Jan^y 20th

These 24 hours Commences with heavy gales from the Westward and heavy squalls of Rain and Wind haying too under a Close Reefed main topsail and main Spencer it being too rough to run at 7 P.M. more moderate kept of NW under a Double Reefed main topsail fore sail and Close Reefed fore topsail middle Part squally Set Sail and took in as occasion required latter Part Wind from the NW and Pleasant Weather Steering NW by E on a Wind on bent the main topgalant sail to Repair So Ended this Day Latth 43° 12' Lon By Chr 46° 05' West

Tuesday Jan^y 21th

First Part of this Day Wind NW and Pleasant Weather Steering NW by E Set fore topmast Standing sail middle Part light Winds from the Westward latter Part light airs from the Southward Steering N by E Set lower Standing sail and fore topgalant Standing sails at 11 A.M. finished the main topgalant sail and bent it and set main topgalant Standing sail So Ended this Day several fin Back Whales in sight but No White or open

Wednesday Jan^y 22th

All these 24 hours fine Pleasant Weather with light Wind from the SE Steering N by E saw several fin Back Whales No White on bent the main topgalant sail to Repair men variously Employed at 10 A.M. bent the main topgalant sail So Ended this Day
