

Towards Home March 12<sup>th</sup> 1845

Wednesday March 12<sup>th</sup>  
All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather  
with light trades steering N.W.  
Men employed in Ships Duty  
Painting and so fourth so ends  
Lat 14° 32' North  
Lon By Chron 50° 44' West

Thursday March 13<sup>th</sup>  
All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather  
with light trades steering N.W.  
1 P.M. set topgalant Studding  
Sails 7 A.M. the wind hauled  
N.W. took in topgalant Studding  
Sails men employed in painting  
so ends this day  
Lat 15° 48' N  
Lon By Chron 52° 13' West

Friday March 14<sup>th</sup>  
First Part of this Day light trades  
and pleasant weather employed in  
painting and so fourth middle part  
squalls of rain and wind took in  
and set sail as occasion required  
latter part light winds from the  
N.W. and pleasant weather  
steering N.W. so ends this  
day Lat 16° 48' N  
Lon By Chron 53° 31'

Saturday March 15<sup>th</sup>  
First and middle parts of this day  
light trades from N.W. latter part  
N.W. and rising clouds set Studding  
sails steering N.W. about  
the mainsail at 6 A.M. to repair  
so ends this day employed  
in repairing the main sail  
Lat 17° 56' North  
Lon By Chron 55° 02' West

Bound to the Northward 1845

Sunday March 16<sup>th</sup>  
All these 24 hours fine N.W. trades  
steering N.W. Studding sails set this day  
at 5 P.M. finished repairing the main  
sail and bent it again at 6 P.M. 212  
set lower Studding sail 1 P.M. along  
with leaving from N.W. so ends  
Lat 19° 22' North  
Lon By Chron 55° 37' West

Monday March 17<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours commences with light winds  
from the S.E. steering N.W. with all hand  
ing sails set at 8 P.M. hauled up all lower  
middle part moderate wind and pleasant  
steering N.W. by N latter part wind  
S.E. steering N.W. so ends the  
24 hours Lat 20° 36' North  
Lon By Chron 57° 42' West

Tuesday March 18<sup>th</sup>  
First Part of this Day pleasant winds from  
S.E. steering N.W. middle part  
the same at 4 P.M. the wind shifted  
to the Westward in it squalls took  
in Studding sails and braced up  
at 8 A.M. wind South set  
Studding sails again so ends  
with light southerly wind  
Lat 21° 49' North  
Lon By Chron 58° 48' West

Wednesday March 19<sup>th</sup>  
All these 24 hours light air from the Southward  
steering N.W. so ends this day  
Lat 22° 21' North  
Lon By Chron 59° 22' West
