Thursday the 24th of October, 1850
Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.E.
heading S.W. middle part squally with rain.
latter part fresh breezes from the S.E. three sails in
sight. the watch employed in ships duties. Lat 29° 24' N
Long no obs

Friday the 25th
Commenced with fresh breezes from the E.S.E.
heading S. broke out for Butter, and meat.
middle and latter parts the same one sail in
sight. Lat 27° 40' N
Long 37° 00' W

Saturday the 26th
Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.E. heading
S.W. middle and latter parts squally with
rain. two sails in sight. Lat no obs.
Long no obs.

Sunday the 27th
Commenced with fresh breezes from the E.
heading E.S.E. employed in setting up the
Rigger. two sails in sight middle and
latter parts squally with rain and variable
winds heading on different tracks Lat no obs
Long no obs

Monday the 28th
Commenced with fresh gales from the E.
storing S.E. double reefed the Topsails furled
the jib. with rainy weather middle part the
same latter part moderate breezes from the
S.E. by E. heading S by W. shook the reefs out
of the Topsails set the main top gallant
sail with squally weather. Lat 24° 32' N
Long 28° 37' W

Upward Bound.
Tuesday the 29th of October, 1850.
Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.E. by E.
heading S by W. unrent the mizen Topsail and
repaired it. middle and latter parts the same
repaired the jib. three sails in sight and
plenty of Gunboats. Lat 22° 34' N
Long 29° 30' W

Wednesday the 30th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E.
heading S.E. middle and latter parts squally. the
watch employed in ships duties. Lat 20° 46' N
Long 28° 25' W

Thursday the 31st
Commenced with strong breezes from the E. heading
S.E. middle and latter parts more moderate
made all sail. repaired a stoven Board. Lat 18° 20' N
Long 27° 49' W

Friday the 1st of November.
Commenced with fresh breezes from the E. heading
S.E. employed in setting up the head Rigger.
middle and latter parts squally. Lat 17° 31' N
Long 26° 44' W

Saturday the 2nd
Commenced with strong breezes from the E. heading
S.E. middle and latter parts more moderate
made all sail. employed in setting up the Rigger.
one sail in sight. Lat 16° 46' N
Long 26° 23' W

Sunday the 3rd
Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.E. by E.
heading S by W. middle part squally with rain. and
lightning. latter part fresh breezes from the E.S.E.
saw a shoal of Black Fish and two ships.
Lat 15° 53' N
Long 25° 55' W
