Monday the 4th Of November. 1850
Commenced with fresh breezes from the
E by S heading S by E. middle and latter parts
more moderate. Tacked ship several times.

Commenced with fine breezes from the E heading
N.N.E middle and latter parts the same. broke out
for Broad and Water.

heading S.E. by S. with squally weather and rain
middle and latter parts calm. at 11 P.M. made
the Islands of Pogo and Bravo. one sail in sight.

Thursday the 7th
Commenced with light airs and calms. the
Islands of Pogo and Bravo in sight.
middle part fine breezes from the E. lying of
and on at Bravo. latter part calm. the ship
Amythest in sight.

Friday the 8th
Commenced with light breezes from the E.
lying of and on at Bravo. middle part
calm latter part fine breezes from the N.E.
at 8 A.M. the Boat went ashore.

Saturday the 9th
Commenced with light breezes from the N.E.
lying of and at Bravo. at 5 P.M. the captain
came on board. and steered S.W. middle and
latter parts light airs and calms three sails in
sight. sent the main top gallant sail.

Sunday the 10th Of November. 1850
Commenced with light airs from the E.S.E steering
S the Islands of Bravo and Pogo in sight. all
hands employed in bending old sails. three
ships in sight. middle and latter parts fine
breezes from the E.

Monday the 11th
Commenced with fine breezes from the E.
steering S by E middle and latter parts the
same. employed at work on the Riggin.

Tuesday the 12th
Commenced with light breezes from the E.N.E
steering S. all hands employed at work on the
Riggin. middle part the same. latter part
squally with rain. one sail in sight.
