Commences with light breezes from the W. heading S.W. one sail in sight. at 8 P.M. the wind hauled N.W. steering W.S.W. latter part strong gales from the N.W. heading N.W. under close reefed main Topsail and reefed Foresail.

Commences with strong gales from the N.W. heading N.W. under close reefed main topsail and reefed Fore and middle and latter parts more moderate with rain squalls washed several times.

Commences with fresh gales from the N.W. heading South 5 sails in sight. middle part fresh gales from the W. by N. latter part variable with heavy squalls and rain. the ship under. there reefed Topsails and reefed Courses.
