Monday the 20th of January AD. 1851.
Commences with strong gales from the W. heading
S.W. by S. under close reefed Topsails and reefed courses.
one sail in sight middle part the same latter part more
moderate two Barks in sight Lat 59.05 south
Long 70.00 West

Tuesday the 21st

Commences with fresh gales from the W. heading S.W.
under double reefed Topsails three sails in sight. at 10 AM
signals with an English Bark middle part more
moderate. latter part variable winds with squally weather
three sails in sight. Lat 59.36 south
Long 72.33 West

Wednesday the 22nd

Commences with fresh gales from the W. heading
S.W. three sails in sight. middle part fresh gales from
the S.W. by S. with squally weather. called all Hands to hoist
sail latter part more moderate. Lat 58.26 south
Long 73.24 West

Thursday the 23rd

Commences with light breezes from the W. heading
N.W. under all sail. three sails in sight. caught
a Porpoise. middle part the same. tacked ship to the S.W.
latter part fine breezes from the S.W. heading W.S.W.
with foggy weather. Lat 58.28 south.
Long no obs.

Friday the 24th

Commences with fine breezes from the S.W.
with sailing weather. steering W.S.W. two sails in
sight. middle part fine breezes from the W.S.W. with
foggy weather. latter part the same. two sails
in sight. Lat 58.41 south
Long 70.43 West

Outward Bound.

Saturday the 25th of January AD. 1851.
Commences with strong breezes from the N.W. by N.
heading W. by S. spoke with the ship Roman. Cripp 54
months out 120 sperm. took in the Top gallant sails.
double reefed the Topsails middle part the same latter part
fresh gales 4 sails in sight. Lat 58.40 south
Long no obs

Sunday the 26th

Commences with fresh gales from the W. heading
S.W. with foggy weather 4 sails in sight. at 6 PM. were
ship to the N.W. middle part the same latter part
more moderate. Lat 57.12 south
Long 81.48 West

Monday the 27th

Commences with fresh breezes from the W. heading N.W.
two sails in sight at 8 PM. were ship to the S.W. middle
and latter parts light airs and calms. with rain squalls
broke out for Bread and Water. Lat 56.44 south
Long 82.10 West

Tuesday the 28th

Commences with light breezes from the S.W. steering
N.W. sent up the Fore topmast studding sail Booms
and set the sail. 5 sails in sight. middle part
squally latter part light breezes from the W. sent a new W.
jib and Mizen Topsail. Lat 54.44 south
Long 82.23 West

Wednesday the 29th

Commences with fine breezes from the S. steering
N.W. by N. 7 sails in sight. middle and latter part
light airs and calms. 8 sails in sight. with pleasant
weather. Lat 53.17 south
Long no obs.
